## Conversational Japanese Language Course, Starter A1, Module 1

Hi everyone, I am Miki from Japan. I am the owner and teacher of the Amieke Online Japanese Language School. In this video, I am going to show you what you can do in Japanese when you have completed Module 1 after the very first 6 lessons. So, please take a look.

Slide 2: はじめまして。わたしは みきです。

Hajimemashite. Watashi wa Miki des.

Hello, I am Miki.

にほんじんです。

Nihonjin des.

I am Japanese.

Slide 3: ここは どこですか。そうです。オランダです。

Koko wa doko desu ka. Soo des. Oranda des.

Where is this? Yes, that is right. This is the Netherlands.

わたしは オランダに すんでいます。

Watashi wa Oranda ni sundeimas.

I live in the Netherlands.

Slide 4: わたしは にほんごの きょうしです。

Watashi wa nihongo no kyooshi des.

I am a Japanese language teacher.

えいごが できます。オランダごも すこし できます。

Eego ga dekimas. Orandago mo sukoshi dekimas.

I can speak English. I can also speak Dutch a little.

Slide 5: これは わたしの あさごはんです。

Kore wa watashi no asagohan des.

This is my breakfast.

わたしは よく くだものを 食(た)べます。

Watashi wa yoku kudamono o tabemas.

I often eat fruit.

いつも こうちゃを 飲(の)みます。

Itsumo koocha o nomimas.

I always drink tea.

Slide 6: みなさんは にほんの 食(た)べものが すきですか。

Minasan wa nihon no tabemono ga suki desu ka.

Do you like Japanese foods?

なにが すきですか。

Nani ga suki desu ka.

What do you like?

わたしは うどんが すきです。

Watashi wa udon ga suki des.

I like Udon noodles.

ラーメンも よく 食(た)べます。

Raamen mo yoku tabemas.

I often eat Ramen as well.

So, how was it? If you are a complete beginner, or if you find it difficult to talk about yourself in this way, then Module 1 is the right level for you. We are going to start with reading Japanese characters and basic greetings.

If you think you can already do this in Japanese, then you can consider participating in a higher level.
